## SPC Comment: Support

But would like to draw your attention to the flood risk report. It omits to mention that in this area the Holvwell Nodular chalk formation is overlaid quaternary alluvial drift deposits consisting of clay, sand or gravel. If layers of clay underlie the site, permeability soil could significantly reduced. Since the site level falls towards Mill Lane. there is a risk of the site draining into the rear garden of 41 Mill Lane and roadway. We ask for a more detailed survey of the underlying geology and details of any remedial measures necessary to be provided before planning permission is issued
