6 PLANNING DECISIONS

There were no planning decisions for the period 25 September – 22 October 2012.

7 SAWSTON SIGNS

The Clerk had obtained quotes for various Sawston signs and it was again discussed at length with no real decision.

It was *PROPOSED* to *RECOMMEND* to Full Parish by Councillor Mrs S A Hatton and *SECONDED* by Councillor W N Reid that as this was a major proposal the decision should be made at Full Parish and not by the Committee.

8 TREE – CAMBRIDGE ROAD

Councillor E C Murray explained that the Clerk had walked round the village with Ms R Richardson, SCDC Trees Officer and inspected all the trees that were on the original tree Inspection Report. The Clerk then created a list of the work needed to these trees that was recommended and obtained three quotes for each. There was one tree that was recommended to be felled immediately which was a Red Horse Chestnut on Spicers Sports Ground due to its condition.

It was **PROPOSED** to **RECOMMEND** to Full Parish by Councillor E C Murray and **SECONDED** by Councillor Miss S E Clarke that as the Parish Council had the budget to do all the work recommended, this work should go ahead.

As some of these trees are to be felled, the Clerk was asked to put a notice on each of these trees explaining why they were being felled and if anyone had any comments to visit the Office.

9 CHANGE BINS IN HIGH STREET

It was explained that there were 11 bins that needed replacing in the High Street due to their deteriorated condition and the Clerk had obtained 3 quotes. It was bought up that one of the bins replaced recently was rusty at the bottom and this should be looked into with the supplier before making a decision. Clerk to contact the supplier and report back to next Planning & Environment Committee Meeting.

10 CIRCUS

Circus Tyanna had written to the Parish Council asking if they could visit Sawston in 2013. Mr A R Poole, Head Groundsman, was happy for them to visit Lynton Way between the end of May and middle of July. It was *PROPOSED* by Councillor E C Murray that the Parish Council has no objection but will need to give them timings for their arrival and departure so as not to disturb the close neighbours.

11 FUTURE DEVELOPMENT PLANS

Suggestions made as follows:

- Councillor Miss S E Clarke would like to see the bench replaced at the bottom of Church Lane
- The safety of the old drying shed was discussed. Clerk to contact building control (Listed Buildings) concerning the safety of the site and ask them to inspect it annually and report back to the Parish Council.
- Councillor K Cuffley reported some footpaths were not in good condition and needed repairing. Councillor K Cuffley offered to compile a list of the paths/footpaths in the village that needed attention so they could be prioritised and forwarded to the County Council.
