# 7 PUBLIC FOOTPATHS

There was a discussion about public footpaths in the village that needed maintenance/improving. The Committee was asked if they could let the Clerk know of any footpaths that needed attention so that she could report them to the County Council to see if they would consider improving them in the future. Clerk to ask County Council Highways Department if someone would be able to meet with some of the councillors who would be able to walk around the footpaths and show the ones that needed the most attention.

The footpath/vehicle access at the Baulkes to Crampton Terrace was discussed as the committee already had concerns about the condition of this path and with the current work being done and lorries using this it was rapidly deteriorating.

It was **PROPOSED** to **RECOMMEND** to Full Council by Councillor E C Murray and **SECONDED** by Councillor R M Richmond that the Clerk writes to SCDC to ask that when the contractors have finished work on the John Falkner site the footpath/vehicle access was left in a reasonable state.

### 8 CORRESPONDENCE

The Parish Council had received a letter from a resident regarding the area at the corner of Whitefield Way and Mill Lane which was used as a workers' depot when ground work was carried out last year down New Road. The understanding was that these surfaces, which were damaged, would be made good upon completion but this has not yet happened.

This was discussed and the land in question belongs to Spicers and the triangular piece of land belongs to the County Council. Clerk to write back to the resident giving this information and letting them know that their comments would be passed on to the County Council.
