We deal only with the most traumatic incidents where there is a severe risk to life.
Explain why your organisation is applying for funding and the purpose for which is will be used	As the only service to run round the clock we respond to emergencies by air during the day and by land between the hours of 7pm and 7am. Our request to the members is for a grant towards the purchase of equipment which will be carried in our Rapid Response Vehicles.

Detail the total cost of each item covered by your funding request (please use separate sheet if needed)	Our request to the members is for a grant of £400 towards the purchase of two haemorrhage pouches at a cost of £232 each. These are used to treat patients with severe bleeding and contain the following:
	 Combat application tourniquet to stop a patient bleeding to death. This is applied over bone to compress arteries and prevent blood loss.
	CELOX - a specialist bandage which comes with a clotting agent to stop excessive bleeding
	- Trauma wound dressings
