3 MINUTES OF THE MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 18 June 2019 were read, confirmed and signed. It was **proposed** by Councillor David Bard and **seconded** by Councillor Tony Fell to **accept** the minutes.

5 UPDATE ON RISK ASSESSMENTS FOR THE CEMETERY GRAVE STONE TESTING

Assistant clerk explained the report consisted of thirty headstones which received work needing to be carried out from low to high risk. Out of the thirty headstones there are eight that are high risk and due to health and safety need the work carried out. Assistant clerk explained that all eight do not have any exclusive rights, for her to contact regarding the work which need doing.

Councillor Kevin Cuffley suggested paying for this work but to get a brake down from the company to insure the best repair.

It was **proposed** by Councillor Kieran Cooper and **seconded** by Councillor David Bard to **recommend to full** to repair the eight high risk stones at a cost £656.

VOTE: 7 FOR : UNANIMOUS

**Action:** Assistant Clerk to contact the company to get a more detailed report on what the repair work involves and roughly how long it will last.

## 6 TO DISCUSS SEPARATE BINS FOR RECYCLED RUBBISH

The Assistant Clerk explained a resident had contacted the Parish Council about having two bins at the new cemetery one for dead flowers and one for all other rubbish. After a lengthy discussion it was suggested a sign to be placed at the Cemetery asking residents to place dead flowers in the skip.

It was **proposed** by Councillor Kevin Cuffley and **seconded** by Councillor Stephen Drew to **agree** to place a sign at the Cemetery.

VOTE: 6 FOR : 1 Against

Action: Assistant Clerk to place a sign at the Cemetery.

# 7 TO DISCUSS A REQUEST FROM A RESIDENT TO HAVE AN ADDITIONAL MEMORIAL TABLET IN FRONT OF HEADSTONE IN GARDEN AREA

The Assistant Clerk explained a funeral director has requested for an additional memorial tablet to be place in front of an existing headstone, after different suggestions it was agreed this would not work at the new cemetery and should be a new rule in Sawston Cemetery rules and regulations.

It was **proposed** by Councillor Kevin Cuffley and **seconded** by Councillor David Bard to **recommend to full** to amend the rules and regulations.

VOTE: 6 FOR : 1 Against
