# 9 TO DISCUSS FIRES AT HUCKERIDGE HILL

The Parish Council received a letter from a resident concerned about the bonfires we have at Huckeridge Hill. They had concerns that household rubbish was being burnt and asked if we could consider an alternative for disposing of village waste. The head grounds keeper confirmed he only burns garden waste, mainly hedge cuttings, and we do have an environmental licence for this. The fire brigade has visited the site before when he was having a fire and were happy with how this was being carried out.

We do get fly tipping on this site but the head grounds keeper does not burn this he will ask SCDC or the scrap man to collect.

It was *proposed* by Councillor Kevin Cuffley and *seconded* by Councillor Michael Mallows to continue as we are and for the Clerk to respond to the resident.
