Cambridgeshire changes from Sunday 11th April 2021

With the planned return of non-essential retail, we will be making alterations to some of our Cambridge services and timetables. All routes that are not listed below will continue to operate to their current timetables

Park & Ride:

Return of service

- To coincide with the re-opening of all non-essential retail, all five Cambridge Park & Ride services will return and will operate to the January 3rd timetables.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 10 minutes Monday-Sunday daytimes and every 20 minutes after 18:00.

Citi 4:

Route amendment

- Following the re-introduction of Park & Ride services, this route will no longer call into Madingley Road Park & Ride.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Citi 5:

Journey amendment

- The 06:50 Cambridge to Bar Hill journey Monday-Friday will operate the evening route via Girton and Oakington. This is to cover for the removal of the 07:05 Citi 6 journey between Cambridge and Oakington.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Citi 6:

Journey amendment

- The 07:05 Citi 6 journey between Cambridge and Oakington will no longer operate. Passengers wishing to travel to Girton and Oakington should instead catch the 06:50 Citi 5, which will serve these villages.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Citi 7:

Route amendments

In response to passenger feedback, we will be making some changes to the Citi 7 route around the Biomedical Campus.

- Buses will now serve Robinson Way and Francis Crick Avenue in both directions.
- Buses will no longer stop on Dame Mary Archer Way, but there are alternative stops outside of the Rosie Maternity Unit which are closer for campus staff to access.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 20 minutes Monday-Saturday daytime between Cambridge and Sawston and every 60 minutes through to Saffron Walden.
- Buses will operate every 60 minutes Monday-Saturday evenings and Sundays between Cambridge and Sawston.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Citi 8:

• There will be a minor timetable alteration between March and Chatteris in both directions. Please check timetables for specific journey times, which may have altered slightly.

Route 11:

Route amendments

- Due to the return of the Park & Ride services, route 11 will no longer serve the Newmarket Road Park & Ride site.
- We will also be making changes to the route in Bury St Edmund's so that we are able to serve the West Suffolk College Campus in both directions.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 60 minutes.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Route 12:

Route amendments

- Due to the return of the Park & Ride services, route 12 will no longer serve the Newmarket Road Park & Ride site.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 60 minutes.

Route 13/13A/13B/X13:

Route amendments

- Due to the return of the Park & Ride services, the 13 routes will no longer serve the Babraham Road Park & Ride site.
- Frequency: Buses will operate to their current frequencies.

Route 18:

Enhanced frequency

- Route 18 will return to its January 3rd timetable.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 60 minutes.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Route 39:

Route amendments

- We will be making some changes to the 39 route so that buses will now serve Lancaster Way Business Park and the route will also be extended to March Railway Station.
- Due to these route changes, there will be some changes made to arrival and departure times, please check the timetable for specific journey time information.
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Route 915:

Route Extension

- We will be extending the 915 route in Royston to serve the new Royston Gateway Retail Park, just off of the A505.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 60 minutes.

Fenstanton and Busway Changes from Sunday 11th April 2021

With the planned return of non-essential retail, we will be making alterations to some of our Fenstanton and Busway services and timetables. All routes will continue their current level of service, except those listed below.

Busway routes A/B/C:

Busway services will revert to the 3rd of January timetables, with some additional alterations which are outlined below:

Route A:

- This route will extend to serve St Ives Morrison's via the Burrell Road industrial estate.
- Frequency: Buses will operate Monday-Saturday every 20 minutes throughout the day (30 minutes on Sunday)

Route B:

• Frequency: Buses will operate Monday-Saturday every 20 minutes throughout the day (30 minutes on Sunday)

Route C:

- Route C will return to operation between Huntingdon and Cambridge via St Ives.
- Frequency: Buses will operate Monday-Friday every 10 minutes at peak times only.
- If you're a student travelling to Long Road Sixth Form College, please use the C service where possible as this will be operated by double deck buses and have a larger capacity than our single deck B service.

Busway A/B/C combines to provide the following frequencies between St Ives and Cambridge:

- 5 minute peak time frequency Monday-Friday
- 10 minute off peak frequency Monday-Friday
- 10 minute daytime frequency on Saturday
- 15 minute daytime frequency on Sunday
- Please note that some stops listed on the timetable are shaded orange, this means that these timings are approximate.

Routes 22:

Route amendments

- We will be making some changes to the route so that buses operate via the Burrell Road industrial estate.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 60 minutes.

Peterborough changes from 18th April 2021

With the planned return of non-essential retail, we will be making alterations to some of our Peterborough services and timetables. All routes will continue their current level of service, except those listed below.

Citi 1:

Route Amendment/ Running Time Adjustment

- In response to passenger feedback, we will be changing the termination points at each end of the route. In Orton, buses will now terminate at Orton Wistow Paulsgrove (end of the Orton loop) instead of Orton Wistow Ferryview. In Werrington, buses will now terminate at Werrington Centre.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 12 minutes Monday-Friday, every 15 minutes on Saturdays and every 20 minutes on Sundays.

Citi 2:

Timetable amendment to serve Peterborough City Hospital

- Journey timings will be adjusted Monday-Friday so that buses do not serve the City Hospital Main Entrance between 7:30-9:00 & 16:30-18:00 as access is restricted at these times.
- Buses will serve the City Hospital Main Entrance throughout the day on Saturdays and Sundays.
- Frequency: Buses will operate every 12 minutes Monday-Saturday and every 30 minutes on Sundays.

Service 23/24:

Route Amendment

- In response to passenger feedback, the termination points on the 23 and 24 routes will be changed from the Marriot Hotel to Commerce Road. The route will continue to serve the Marriot Hotel.
- Service 23 will operate 7 trips outbound and 5 trips inbound Monday-Friday.
- Service 24 will operate 1 trip in both directions Monday-Friday.

Bedford Changes from 12th April 2021

Route 8:

• There is no change to the Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency, but please check timetables for specific journey times, which may have altered slightly.

Route 9 A/B:

• The Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency will be increased to run every 15 minutes from Bedford, with route 9A and 9B both running hourly to Hitchin.

Route 10:

• There is no change to the Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency, but please check timetables for specific journey times, which may have altered slightly.

Route 41:

• There is no change to the Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency, but please check timetables for specific journey times, which may have altered slightly.

Route 51:

• The Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency will be increased from hourly to every 30 minutes.

Route 53:

• The Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency will be increased from every 30 to every 20 minutes.

Route 73:

• The Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency will be increased from hourly to every 30 minutes.

Route 81:

• There is no change to the Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency, but please check timetables for specific journey times, which may have altered slightly.

Route 99:

• There is no change to the Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency, but please check timetables for specific journey times, which may have altered slightly.

Route 905:

- The Monday-Friday frequency will be increased from hourly to every 30 minutes.
- There is no change to the hourly frequency on Saturday, but please check timetables for specific journey times which may have altered slightly.

Route x5:

• There is no change to the Monday-Friday and Saturday frequency, but the service will resume its normal route, extending to Oxford throughout the week.
