2 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST FOR THIS MEETING

Councillor Ian Reeves, item 4 as he is the Chairman of Sawston & Babraham Cricket Club (Non Pecurinary)

3 TO DISCUSS THE TENDERS FOR MILL LANE PAVILION PROJECT

Councillor Kevin Cuffley explained we have received 3 quotes for this project:

- £263,937 + vat
- £309,599 + vat
- £354,567 + vat

There were more companies asked to quote but declined, and all quoted on the same specification.

Councillor Kieran Cooper explained that we have £169,200.00 from S106 for the Challis Close development and we have agreed £35,000.00 from reserves for pavilion maintenance we can use. If we accept the lowest quote, we would have to take the rest from reserves. This was discussed at length.

The Clerk was asked to confirm if we can claim back the VAT on this project which she will look into.

It was **proposed** by Councillor Brian Milnes and **seconded** by Councillor David Bard to **accept** the quote for £263,937 + vat from Jaggard projects Ltd.

4 TO DISCUSS THE TENDERS FOR SPICERS PROJECT

Councillor Kevin Cuffley explained that the quotes for this project (to extend at Spicers for extra storage and cricket scorers box) came in way over budget.

This was discussed and Councillor Brian Milnes recommended we ask Alan Lamb to keep our options open and see if he can come up with an acceptable quote.

One option that was discussed previously with the Head Grounds Keeper was to maybe extend the current garage.

It was *proposed* by Councillor Kieran Cooper and *seconded* by Councillor David Bard to ask Alan Lamb to reconsider the options for Spicers and work on cheaper options.
