## 144 TO DISCUSS LETTER FROM RTC REGARDING RECENT WORK ON WETPOUR ON RECREATION GROUNDS

Councillor Kevin Cuffley explained that we have received a letter from a solicitor acting on behalf of RTC who recently repaired the surface under all the play equipment, threatening to take the parish council to court over non-payment of the work. The parish council did not feel the quality of the work was adequate and are withholding the payment until we seek independent advice. The clerk explained that she has contacted three chartered surveyors, one could not help and two have yet to reply. She has also contact SAPCA (Sports and play construction association) for their advice and is waiting a response. ROSPA has said they will come out to do an inspection and report at a cost of $£ 395.00$.

This was discussed and Councillor lan Reeves, with the agreement of the other councillors explained that we are not experts in this and we should first appoint a solicitor to respond to the letter to explain we are getting independent advice before we agree what we are going to pay.

It was proposed by Councillor Ian Reeves and seconded by Councillor Jayne Merrick for the clerk to approach Adams Harrison Solicitors in the village to ask them to respond to the letter and continue to seek independent advice. The clerk will give an update at the next full parish meeting.
