We aim to enhance their independence, improve their wellbeing, and increase their inclusion in their local community. Cam Sight's services are wide ranging, from Peer Support groups such as in Sawston, volunteer befrienders, emotional support and counselling, sports and leisure, to equipment and tech.

The service we offer is bespoke and based on individual need. We also do not charge clients for Cam Sight's Emotional Support Services, again unlike many other service providers.
