Description of the project	We offer a voluntary youth group affiliated to The Boys' Brigade organisation. We are expecting to have 10 Explorers (school year 1 to 2), 30 Juniors (school years 3 to 6), 18 Seniors (school years 7 to 9) and 14 Amicus (school years 10 to 13) from September. We have a waiting list for our Explorer and Junior sections. We want to provide them with activities that encourage team building, co-operation, strategic skills and physical well being and exercise. They have asked us if they can do Laser Tag which we can use time and time again. This will encourage the young people to work together and hopefully strengthen bonds between children and age groups. We hope it will also improve communication skills. We feel this is a project which would have a lasting impact (not a one off) and could be used many times as part of our programme. We have obtained quoted for the equipment totally £1,731.58.

We are one of the biggest youth groups in South Cambs. We offer activities each week for four difference age groups. We offer the DofE award scheme, a marching band on a Thursday night, educational programmes (we are planning to offer to a first aid course in November 2023) and fun activities. Every leader is a volunteer and no one gets paid anything for what they do. We are successful and well known and have supported many local events with our band - Sawston Fun Run, Sawston Remembrance Day, RBL events, Parish Council events. The Parish Council Chairman recently presented Dofe awards for us. We also support Soham Brigade Youth Group and provide leaders for this each week. We are a limited company registered by guarantee and an independent registered charity. We are affiliated to the Boys' Brigade movement who provide us with staff training, staff qualifications, public liability insurance and safeguarding.
