Describe the overall aim of your organisation and the activities or services it provides	EAAA provides lifesaving advanced pre-hospital emergency medical services to the most critically ill or injured people in the communities we serve in Bedfordshire, Cambridgeshire, Norfolk & Suffolk – 24/7 by air & by road. Working directly at the scene of accidents & medical emergencies, our specialist crews deliver A&E level medical interventions to patients, & transport them quickly & safely to the nearest suitable hospital to meet their ongoing medical needs where necessary.
Explain the direct benefit to Sawston of your organisation's activities including the number of Sawston residents who have benefitted in the past	Supporting EAAA means that anyone within the Sawston parish has access to the advanced medical skills of our specialist medical teams at any time of the day. We also provide specialist Aftercare support to patients, their families & friends, & bystanders after an incident to help on the recovery journey. Our Community Training team deliver free CPR training sessions to groups, clubs, businesses and organisations within the communities we serve. Our clinicians work with other air ambulances, universities and other organisations to develop new interventions and best practice to ensure the best possible outcomes for patients - wherever they may be.

Explain why your Organisation is applying for funding and the purpose for which is will be used	EAAA does not receive any regular government funding and relies on the support and generosity of the incredible people in the region to raise the funds needed to continue to deliver and develop our lifesaving services. Each tasking costs £4,250.00 and we are called out on average eight times each day. A donation of £500.00 helps us procure the day to day medical equipment we need to ensure our crews have everything they need to attend patients as well as support them after their incident and continue to improve knowledge of what to do in a medical emergencies such as out of hospital cardiac arrests (the most common reason we are called out) within our communities. This is only possible with public support.
Detail the total cost of each item covered by your funding request (please use separate sheet if needed)	A donation of £500 helps us to purchase items such as: - Blizzard heat blankets to keep patients warm (30.50 ea) - Celox gauze to help the clotting process for severe bleeding injuries (£37.00 ea) - Retractable scalpels for use in surgical interventions (£1.68 ea) - Sterile glove for use in surgical interventions and part of crew PPE (£0.35/pair) - Sterile surgical scissors for use in surgical interventions (£3.15 ea) - Elastoplast tape to secure paediatric airway tubes (£1.15/roll) - 4 lead ECG cables for use with hear monitors (£149 ea)
