10 TO REVIEW INVESTMENT POLICY

The committee discussed the Investment Policy and agreed that as it is increasingly difficult to find bank/building societies that accept Parish Councils. Because of the amount the Parish Council currently has in the main account, the Clerk recommended the Parish Council should increase the maximum for each account to £120k where possible to disperse the funds and review in a year. The money in all accounts is allocated mainly for the new pavilion at Lynton Way.

It was **proposed** by Councillor Kevin Cuffley and **seconded** by Councillor Paul Allen to **RECOMMEND TO FULL** to accept and adopt the current policy with the above amend and review in a year.
